- 4. Review Community Power program press release from Standard Power, Nashua, who presented briefly at the last Selectmen's meeting
 - The Selectmen directed them to present to the Energy Committee. Likely at the next meeting, May 15.
 - Largest Community power vendor in NH.
 - Offer lower KWh power rates than Eversource and others. (not including delivery and other costs)
 - Will need to present warrant article at Town Meeting for public approval of program.
 - Property owners would need to opt out of the program if they do not want to participate.
 - Rates do not apply to owner produced solar.
 - Better rate depending on how much solar sourced power.
 - They source mostly natural power sources, not natural gas or coal.
 - ISO New England app tells what % of several electric generating fuels used.
 - John will distribute proposal to EC members.
 - NH has the highest power rates in the U.S.
 - No opt in or opt out costs mentioned, need to check.
- 5. School solar electric.
 - Discussed panels location, is there potential roof mounting damage?
- 6. School solar hot water system:
 - No changes
- 7. Progress on tours of Resident's homes for solar and other energy savings.
 - None planned for next few months.
- 8. Town Solar (Transfer Station)
 - David needs figures on how the final \$50K payment affects the system payback affects program costs.
